What to do with my child this Winter ?

Routine : Dressing and Undressing in Winter

Routines help my child know what is expected of them. This gives them a sense of **security** and **confidence**. A routine with pictures helps my child get organized. They can see the order in which they need to do things. This helps my child become more and more **independent**.

At school, my child will have to put on and take off their winter clothes several times a day to go outside and play. They will be proud to be able to do this on their own!



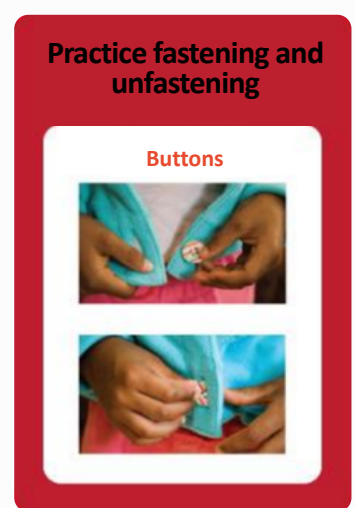
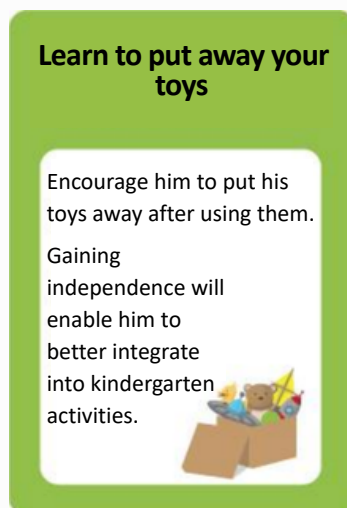
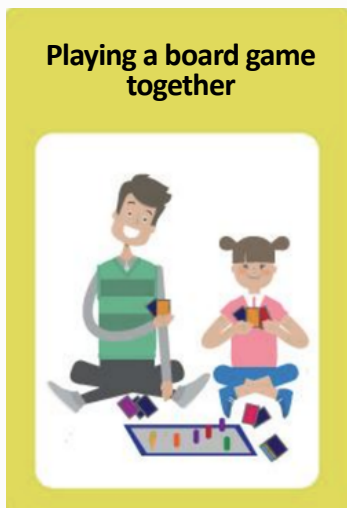
